III. His EXPERIENCE Compels EXPRESSION

Acts 4:19, 20, "Peter and John answered them, Whether it is right in the sight of God to listen to you rather than to God, you must judge; for we cannot but speak of what we have seen and heard."

1. The glory of a personal experience with Christ

2. How this will be expressed.

A. In listening to God rather than to men.

B. In living for others rather than for self

C. In loving Christ rather than mammon

IV. His LOVE Compels DEVOTION, II Cor. 5:14

D. To be laborers together with Him, 6:1
