- D. Able to sympathize with men. Heb. 2:18

II. Suggests the Rejection of Christ

- A. It was a cry of derision
- B. Ridiculed with the crown of thorns & purple robe.
- C. Rejected and crucified
- D. John 1:12 -- You can receive Him.

III. If we Behold Him today it would suggest His Dignity.

- A. His name "Jesus", as a wonderful Savior
Accept Him in your heart
- B. His name "Christ", the promised Messiah
