(THIS COULD AND SHOULD HAVE BEEN TO THEM WHAT THE CROSSING
OF THE JORDAN WAS TO THE NEXT GENERATION.)
SENDING OUT THE SPIES REVEALED THEIR UNBELIEF —
SHUTTING GOD OUT. (SEE DEUT. 1)-P.22)

1. WHAT WE LOSE OF THE LAND OF MILK AND HONEY
2. WHAT WE ENDURE IN A PROLONGED WILDERNESS EXPERIENCE.
3. IF WE CHANGE OUR MINDS TOMORROW, IT MAY THEN BE TOO LATE.
IT IS NOT A QUESTION OF MISSING ETERNAL LIFE, BUT
A QUESTION OF MISSING GOD'S CHOICEST BLESSING.
4. YOUR TURNING BACK MAY BE KEEPING SOMEONE ELSE FROM
CROSSING OVER.

VI. WHAT ABOUT THOSE OF YOU WHO TURNED BACK YEARS AGO FROM YOUR KADESH-BARNEA?

1. GOD'S GRACE WAS WITH THEM EVEN IN THE WILDERNESS.
2. IT IS BETTER HUMBLY TO ENDURE GOD'S DISCIPLINE THAN TO TRY TO TAKE MATTERS INTO YOUR HAND.
3. TO MANY OF THEM (THOSE UNDER 20 YEARS OLD) GOD GAVE ANOTHER CHANCE AND 40 YEARS LATER THEY CROSSED OVER THE JORDAN WITH JOSHUA THEIR LEADER.
