

"Lessons From Lot's Life"

- I. He was without a call; he simply "Tagged along" with Abraham.
- A. Gen. 12:4 "And Lot went with him"
 - B. There are many today who pretend to want to serve Christ, but they are without a personal experience, call, or connection, and are simply going along with someone else.
- II. Lot was without the consecration needed to walk along with Abraham.
- A. He made a selfish choice (13:10-13) apart from any consideration of God's will
 - B. He wasn't concerned about having to live with exceedingly wicked sinners
 - C. For the sake of luxury and ease he was willing to ~~be in the~~ ^{be in the} midst of temptation.
- III. He was without a testimony, having no godly influence either in the city or among his own family.
- A. 19:14 "He spoke unto his sons in law, but he seemed as one that mocked to them"
 - B. 19:36 - His daughters were with child by their fathers - drunken, incestuous debauchery.
- IV. He was without the spiritual blessing of God, even though he did gain great material wealth + social position.
- A. V. 13:5 - wealth, possessions
 - B. 19:1 - position of prominence
 - C. God never appeared to him at the altar as to Abraham.

- IV. This brought on him severe
 chastening + judgment, partly
 escaping with his life.
- A. Ch. 14 Captured by the foreign kings
 and delivered by Abraham
 - B. Barely escaped in the destruction
 of Sodom, losing his wife.
 - C. Lot is a man who made the
 least of unusual opportunities
