Scripture: Gen. 6:1-13; Luke 17:26: II Tim. 3:1-7

I. What were the days of Noah like?

A. See Gen. 6:1-13

1. "Giants" = nephilim, from ^{TS}TS, he fell; those who had fallen, or apostatized from the true religion. Septuagint trans. γίγαντες, gigantes, literally signifies earth-born. Fallen, earthborn men, with an animal devilish mind.
2. v. 3 - They were flesh, wholly sensual, following the lust of the flesh.
3. Their wickedness was great, v. 5, continually increasing & multiplying.
4. v. 11, wholly earth corrupt, and filled with violence, & murder.
5. all the imaginations of their thoughts were evil. an evil mind poisoned every thought, purpose, wish, desire, motive.
6. Evil continually, without mixture of good.

B. Luke 17:27-

1. Eating & drinking - concerned only for the body & not the soul.
2. marrying & divorcing - marriage - divorce & multiple marriages.

C. Completely unrepentant for 120 yrs.

II. Parallel conditions in our own time.

- A. Luke 17:26 - "and as it was in the days of Noe, so shall it be also in the days of the Son of Man."
- B. Concerned with eating & drinking, caring for the body but not the soul - right for men
- C. Widespread divorce on senseless & silly grounds and multiple marriages
- D. Gratifying the sexual lust of the flesh
Immorality, rape & murder -
1. J. Edgar Hoover says the depraved sex criminal has replaced the kidnapper as our greatest public enemy.
2. Note horrible example of numerous child molestations & slayings.
3. The social dance today is an evil influence that arouses the basest sexual passions, leading to immorality, indecency, divorce and ~~down~~ bawdiness & murder.
