I. The purpose of the throne.

- A. To obtain mercy and grace to help in time of need.
- B. Some thrones are symbols of judgment and justice, but this one is a throne of mercy and grace.
- C. It is a priestly throne, not a kingly throne.
- D. It is called the throne of grace, because it is the throne where our gracious God meets us and answers our requests.
- E. Therefore we need not be anxious for anything; He gives peace instead of worry. (Phil. 4:6,7)

II. The approach to the throne.
