I. Bloody Highways of the Nation

1. Murder on the highways,  
Judges 20:31, "The children of Benjamin went out against the people, and they began to kill in the highways."

More people were killed on highways of U.S. during world war II than were killed on our global battle-fronts.  
*2 Kings 9:20 - "He drives furiously"*

2. Need for caution and safety.
3. Sanctity of human life in the Christian philosophy in particular and in the moral law in general.
4. Immanuel Kant said two things filled him with awe, the starry firmament above and the moral law within.

II. The Crowded Highway to Hell

1. Mt. 7:13, "Broad is the way that leads to destruction, and many there be which go in thereat."
2. It is crowded because:
  - A. It is a popular way
  - B. It is an easy way
  - C. It appeals to man's pride  
(Someone said "one of the smallest packages we ever saw was a man wholly wrapped up in himself.")
3. Its end and destination is destruction & hell
4. This highway ~~must~~ be avoided at all costs

III. The Highway of Salvation through Christ

1. Isa. 40:3, "Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make straight in the desert a highway for our God."
2. Jesus is called the Way. Jn. 14:6
  - A. The Way to Heaven.
  - B. Way or Example of holy living.

Acts 9:2; 22:4.

3. Ps. 16:11, "Thou wilt show me the path of life"
4. In taking Christ as the way of salvation, we must do so by faith and personal experience before trying to rationalize. Dr. Arthur Eddington of Cambridge discusses an example of this as follows:



"I am standing on the threshold about to enter a room.  
It is a complicated business.  
In the first place, I must shove against an atmosphere  
pressing with a force of 14 pounds on every square inch  
of my body.

I must make sure of landing on a plank traveling at  
20 miles a second around the sun.  
I must do this while hanging from a round planet  
head outward in space, and with a wind of ether blowing  
at no one knows how many miles a second through every  
part of my body.

The plank has no solidity of substance.  
To step on it is like stepping on a swarm of flies.  
Shall I not slip through?

Verily, it is easier for a camel to pass through the  
eye of a needle than for a scientific man to pass  
through a door.

And whether this door be barn door or a church door,  
it would be wiser that he should consent to be an ordi-  
nary man and walk in rather than wait until all the  
scientific difficulties are resolved."

5. Christ is the door to salvation, and we must step  
through this door by faith, whether or not we  
understand all about how he saves us.

A. Mk. 10:46, "Bartimaeus sat by the highway side begging."

B. Hymn. "Out in the highways and byways of life.

highway, Mt. 25:34-40.  
3. We have many opportunities to serve the needy and sick  
along the highway of life.  
Mt. 25:34-40, "Whosoever ye shall find by the highway side bring  
in." "And in the future and because of life."
