9. WATCH FOR THE CONFIRMATION OF DIVINE PROVIDENCE IN SURROUNDING CIRCUMSTANCES.
- A. WAIT UNTIL YOU ARE SURE OF GOD'S PURPOSE.
- B. DISCIPLINE YOUR SPIRIT TO RECOGNIZE THE LEAST SIGN OF GOD'S WILL.
