- C. Gazing at Jesus, being occupied with Him (stone face) become like Him.

# THE IMAGE OF GOD

Col. 1:9-20; 3:1-10  
1:15

INTRODUCTION: God hates image worship, whether they are images of false gods or of the true God. The Bible speaks of the image of God in the abstract, not in the concrete.  
(Story of the professor who said he liked children "in the abstract, not in the concrete").

## I. Man was created in the image of God. Gen. 1:26,27

A. Direct act of creation.

B. Likeness of personality: intellect, emotion, and will.

C. Likeness of spirituality & immortality.

D. Likeness of righteousness & holiness. (originally)

E. Likeness of dominion and power.

F. This likeness of God shows the VALUE of the soul (sculptor like Michaelangelo who said of a large block of marble, "I see an angel in it, and I am going to liberate her.")

## II. The Image of God Lost in Eden by Sin.

A. Adam sinned.

In Eden the slimy serpent of sin reared its ugly head and sank its poisonous fangs into the bloodstream of humanity.

B. Likeness of righteousness & holiness completely lost, and other likenesses seriously marred. Adam and Eve were no longer sinless and no longer immortal.

C. All adam's sons & daughters born in sin, Gen. 5:3.

Ps. 51, "born in sin, conceived in iniquity."

Rom. 5, "By one man sin entered into the world."

## III. The Image of God Revealed in Christ

A. Christ is the Second Adam.

B. 2 Cor. 4:4, "Christ, who is the image of God."

C. Col. 1:15, "Who is the image of the invisible God."

D. Heb. 1:3, "the express image of his person."

E. His life reveals his perfect holiness and answers for us the question, "What is God like?"

#### IV. The Image of God Renewed in Man through the Redemptive work of Christ.

A. Rom. 8:29, "Whom he foreknew, them he also predestined to be conformed to the image of His son."

B. Col. 3:10, "the new man which is renewed after the image of him that created him."

1. An image of humility
2. An image of love
3. An image of righteousness
4. An image of sacrifice (Story of the 4 Chaplains)
5. An image of glory, "Changed into the same

image with Christ from glory to glory" (2 Cor 3:18)

CONCLUSION: 1 Cor. 15:48 - "The image of the man of dust... the man of heaven."

Like the man in Hawthorne's story, we should be gazing so steadfastly at the face of Jesus, until others notice that we are actually becoming like him.

Pick up a coin and note whose image and superscription you find on it.

Then consider your life as the coin of the heavenly realm. Whose image is on your life, the mottoes and symbols of a mundane world, or the image of Jesus Christ?
